July 16th Meeting: Hosea Youth Services - Youth Homeless is Growing Locally



Brad Bills, Executive Director of Hosea Youth Services, will be our speaker this Tuesday. Brad has had the opportunity to serve young people for over 25 years, first as the Executive Director for Rogue Valley Youth for Christ (YFC) in Medford for over 16 years and then as a National Field Director for YFC for over 8 years. As a National Field Director, he supported and served 25 YFC chapters on the West Coast. He began as the Hosea Director April 1, 2019.

Brad grew up in Medford, was active in many sports and was impacted by the organization Fellowship of Christian Athletes. He attended UO, graduating with a degree in Business â€" Finance. After spending most of his life in Southern Oregon, he is excited to be in Eugene where his family has lived for many years.

Brad enjoys playing golf, running, hiking, reading and attending Duck athletic events.

While he has many years of nonprofit leadership experience, he has been on a fast track to learn about youth homelessness and the significant challenges these young people face. He looks forward to continuing to learn, serving and encouraging the local community to be more engaged in loving and impacting these kids.

Brad will speak to the issue of homelessness in our community and how Hosea is striving to "catch†our young people now, to provide the support and services they need to work through their barriers and get to a place where they can take care of themselves. The road to a life of health and purpose is long and hard, and we must do all we can to come alongside and show them a pathway out.
