

August 6th Meeting: Eugene 4J School District

The Rotary Club of Eugene's program for August 6th will feature School District 4J Interim Superintendent Colt Gill and 4J Board Chair Jenny Jonak. Superintendent Gill and Chairperson Jonak will tag team to provide updates on the; health of the district; the vision and goals of the Board; and upcoming challenges. Time will be reserved for questions from the audience.



Colt Gill was born and has lived in Lane County his entire life and has deep ties to our community. He has been an Oregon educator for over 34 years; serving as a teacher, principal, district technology director, curriculum & instruction director, assistant superintendent, and superintendent all in Lane County.

Colt joined the 4J School District as the Interim Superintendent in April 2024 and will continue to serve through this school year as the School Board completes a search for a permanent Superintendent. In 2016, Governor Brown appointed Colt to serve as Oregon's first Education Innovation Officer. In this position he focused on improving graduation outcomes by working with local communities, school districts, researchers, students, and other stakeholders to identify effective practices across the Preschool to higher education continuum and make recommendations to the Governor, state agencies, and the Legislature regarding policies, budget priorities and supports needed to increase the number of students who graduate prepared for their next steps in the work place or college. Colt then went on to serve as the Director

of the Oregon Department of Education and Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction under Governors Brown and Kotek.

Colt has served a number of statewide local efforts to improve education and health outcomes for children, including: The Quality Education Commission, the Oregon State Board of Education, the Board of the Coalition of Oregon School Administrators, the Government-to-Government Education Cluster, the United Way of Lane County, the Lane County Coordinated Care Organization; the Lane Coalition for Healthy Active Youth Board; and the Oregon Social Learning Center Board.



Jenny Jonak is an attorney who has practiced law for 27 years. She founded her own law firm, Jonak Law Group, P.C., that specializes in complex commercial litigation. Jenny also holds a real estate broker's license. Jenny has served in a number of community and non-profit positions, including Chair of the Eugene 4J School Board, Council of Korean Americans, Lane County Charter Review Committee, Chair of the Lane County Law Library Committee, Steering Committee for the Lane County Campaign for Equal Justice, Lane County Bar Association Diversity Equity & Inclusion Committee, President of Round Table Club, President of Friends of Eugene Public Library, Board of Directors of Square One Villages, Board of Directors of Oregon Bach Festival, and others. Jenny is the proud parent of four children, three of whom are students in the Eugene 4J schools. In her spare time, she enjoys growing specialty cut flowers and heirloom vegetables, attending oldtime fiddle jams, photographing nature, and reading medieval Icelandic sagas.


