John L. Cleaveland is a contemporary artist who lives and works in Farmington, Georgia. Known for his breathtakingly realistic oil paintings, he offers viewers a timeless glimpse into iconic Southern scenes as well as vast pastoral expanses of the United States, Europe, and Southeast Asia.

Mr. Cleaveland received his BFA from the University of Georgia and held a Graduate Assistantship in the UGA Study Abroad Program in Cortona, Italy. He has exhibited his work at the Huntsville Museum of Art, the Albany Museum of Art, Blue Spiral 1 Gallery, University of Georgia, Madison Morgan Cultural Center, Lyndon House Art Center, and the Missouri State Botanical Gardens. His paintings are in the permanent collections of the Asheville Art Museum, the UGA State Botanical Garden of Georgia, the Combat Art Collection at the U.S. Marine Corps Museum, the Morris Museum of Art, 3-M Company, Bessemer Trust, and the Alabama Power Company.
