### Katherine Dobie Camp Sunshine



Katherine told us a little about Camp Sunshine where she was one of the very first campers as a teenager battling Leukemia. The camp started in 1983 on Lake Burton but grew large and was later moved to a new site with many facilities.

Katherine was diagnosed with Leukemia when she was 6 years old and was treated at St. Jude in Memphis for over 2 years, there being no applicable pediatric treatment in Atlanta. She went into remission, but it then suddenly relapsed, and she had to get 2 more years of treatment at St. Jude during which time new and improved treatments for Leukemia were developed her need to visit St. Jude eventually ended. Katherine first went to Camp Sunshine when she was 15. Her father came the first year taking photographs...then her mother, grandparents, and other family members worked there as counselors. She immediately made life-long friends. Katherine continued to be involved with the camp for many years and has stayed in touch with many of the campers she counseled.

These teams work on the patrol shifts and are available for all divisions of GCPD. The K-9 teams are on-call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and operate throughout the county. The K-9 Teams are also available to provide mutual aid to law enforcement and public safety agencies across southeast Georgia.
