Brunswick Mayor Cosby Johnson

Crosby began with a shout-out to Donna Davis & Dialo Cartwright for their support of the community at the local and state levels. He emphasized his desire for transparency in government regardless of differing views.

Crosby then talked about some of the issues addressed since becoming mayor. The Brunswick Housing Authority was investigated and found to have mismanaged \$17MM in funds over the last 15 years. The director and 4 members were replaced. He also opened up the Procurement process information

to the public.

When Crosby became mayor, the police force was down 60%, and the fire department down 48%. He changed the pay structure and offered other benefits including training and education and help with living costs if residing in the city. The fire department is now at 110% and the police at 93%. The police department also now has a gang investigation unit, and they are working on bringing back bike and foot officers who can have conversations with the homeless.

Dialo and Donna helped with a trip to Atlanta to obtain funds from the State to renovate Howard Coffin Park.Crosby also realizes that there needs to be more than low-income development.There has been \$63MM invested in the downtown in the last 2-1/2 years.
