Olive Farm

Tommie and Stephanie Willaims joined us to share their <u>olive farm</u> story.Tommie started the story discussing his background as a Georgia Senator first elected in 1998. As a Senator from January 1999-2017, Tommie represented the 19th district serving as Senate Majority leader in 2005. In 2018, he was appointed by the U.S. Agriculture Secretary, Sonny Perdue, to be the Minister-Counselor for Agriculture at the U.S. Mission to the United Nations Agencies for Food and Agriculture in Rome, Italy.

Tommie's experience in Italy helped to inspire him to grow olives on his land. Tommie and his wife have experimented with different types of olive trees to find the best types of olive trees to grow in Georgia. He discussed the issues unique to Georgia such as humidity, intermittent frosts, and mites.

Tommie and Stephanie turned their olives into excellent award-winning olive oil. Both discussed the unique qualities of the different varieties of olives on the farm. In addition, they discussed the health benefits of consuming olive oil. Rotarians in the audience added their own stories of how olive oil has improved their health.

Tommie and Stephanie hope to invite us in the future to their olive farm.
