support. We have received many "get well" cards and some of you have signed up on the "meal train". Choo Choo. Heidi brought me a weight loss pie, although I have yet to see the weight loss even though I have eaten the entire pie. Maybe she can clarify this at some point.

Dennis was just moved to the Rehabilitation Hospital of the NorthWest in Post Falls. He has only just started sitting up and they require him to attend all three meals, so he is already doing more than he has done in the last four weeks. His infection is improving, although it is painfully slow because it is now in the bone, specifically in L4 and L5. He will be on IV antibiotics for another four weeks at least and then we will reassess for possible extended antibiotics and more PT. We are anxious to have him home soon. We miss how he comes into the living room, changes the TV to the football game, and then leaves the room. Please accept our gratitude for all of the well wishes.
