Steve spoke about Fallen Heroes Plaza and the 9/11 Memorial at the base of Cherry Hill Park on 15th Street in CDA. The planning began in 2006, our club donated \$25,000 to the project, and it was completed and dedicated in 2009. All Idaho police and firefighters lost in the line of duty are honored here. There is also a scaled down replica of Ground Zero which was a piece gifted from the FDNY to CDA Fire. Currently 343 fire and 72 police have been honored in this special place.
