PROGRAM

GYNII GILLIAM introduced Jacob Bonwell with ATC Manufacturing. Bonwell grew up in Post Falls and completed all of his school there. He is a graduate of the University of Idaho and is very involved in the community and philanthropy. He started Camp Journey NW when he was 22 years old, which serves children and families affected by cancer. He then founded the Sweethearts Ball, which serves as the main fundraiser for Camp Journey NW.

ATC stands for Advanced Thermoplastics Composites, and the goal of the company is to accelerate the use of thermoplastics composites in the aerospace industry. Lakeside Companies is the majority owner of ATC, which supports every Boeing program with primary and secondary products. There is no outsourcing, as ATC manufactures all parts in their Post Falls facility.

Bonwell explained that workforce development is everything to their business. ATC works closely with the University of Idaho School of Engineering to support students and provide a path from the classroom to real-world, hands-on learning within the industry. New technology is speeding up manufacturing with output of products manufactured in parts per second.

ATC is working to build a new 58,000 sq ft facility in Post Falls to respond to the increase in product demand. This would increase jobs by 100+ and would open in late summer. To learn more, view the presentation here.
