Also announced was the election of ANN THOMAS as President-Elect Elect, to take office in July 2026. CONGRATULATIONS TO ALL! A final housekeeping item was the recommendation and approval of revised Bylaws for the club. The meeting closed.

Next was the Annual Update and Shareholder's Meeting for the Coeur d'Alene Rotary Endowment Foundation. Foundation President Ann Thomas, Treasurer Michael Nail and Naomi Boutz provided an update on the impact and investment of the Foundation to support our club's endeavors.

Founded in 2012, currently the endowment totals \$736,354, which is an increase of \$113,304 in 2024. The goal is to reach \$1,000,000. At that point, the club should be able to receive an average of \$40,000 annually to invest in scholarships and grants each calendar year.
