PROGRAMS

Bears in Northern California



John Roney has been Park Manager at Sugarloaf Ridge State Park since 2012. John presented on park activities centered on the arrival of black bears first sighted in the county in 2015. The park, and John's involvement in the North Bay Bear Collaborative (NBBC) sprang from the discovery. Some of the smart actions the team has undertaken include \$150 (instead of \$1,500) per campsite bear-proof-container deployment, scat



analyses collaborating with UC Davis biologists, and the continuous refinement of their good management practices. The Sugarloaf Ridge State Park received an award in 2022 from the California League of Park Associations.

Know that black bears fear humans.

Q: What do I do if I encounter a black bear in or *around my home /* urban area? A: *Ensure the bear has an escape route!*

Q What do I do if I encounter a black bear *in the woods*? A: *Stay still. Be big. DON"T RUN.*

Q: What is the interaction between black bears and mountain lions like? A: In the absence of black bears, a mountain lion will take days to finish consuming a large kill, like a deer. With black bears in the area, park staff never see an unfinished kill.

Q: Did we see on the map some non-park land between Sugarloaf and Hood?

A: Yes, Sonoma Land Trust and the parks continue in their long-view missions. For example, thanks to **Don Mitchell** and fam - and Sonoma Land Trust - the Fitzsimmons Ranch is part of the park.
