Jim D. introduced Mary Volmer of St. Mary's College. Mary's specialty is spirituality in sports. She is the author of two novels *Crown of Dust* and *Reliance Illinois*, was a mission fellow for athletes and a professor/author/chaplain. Mary shared that she coached 12-year-old boys on her son's basketball team and deomnstrated a hand trick with a basketball.

Mary played basketball in college as she earned a college scholarship at Saint Mary's College in Moraga. She said they won a lot, which was great but she was undersized and rarely played.

After college, she studied writing on a Rotary Scholarship at the University of Aberystwyth, Wales. And it was there she decided to write a novel. Mary stated that art is a spiritual act and a human right.

A term she stressed she uses is "The "I" in team. She would often go to the library to read many books and discovered spirituality in sports. Mary became a Mission Fellow, Lay Chaplain and offers spiritual direction to advise athletes in fellowship and she teaches meditation. Mary stresses the Lasallian guiding principle, which is academic excellence, faith formation, inclusion, respect for the individual and service and social justice. She also stresses success is not measured by how high you climb, but it is the whole athlete and whole student.
