Kenn Adams, **Synergy Artistic Director.** Kenn brought a lively interactive program involving our members which explained "classic short form improv. Games. We learned about simple exercises for understanding story structures embraced by improvisers, writers, and teachers such as Kenn, the world over. Here are the 3 rules of improvisation that we learned: 1. Be spontaneous 2. Always make your partner look good 3. Build on your partner's ideas. His work also involves bringing the culture of improvisation into the workplace that are applied to teams that show how improvisational ideas can be used by teams to reach shared goals.
