

The theme was Whiskey Tasting, and Ray had rows of Scotch, Irish, Bourbon and Rye Whiskeys plus a home cooked pulled pork dinner that was delicious. **Ray** discussed flavor profiles of Bourbon, Scotch, Rye and Irish Whiskey. We tasted bourbon (including bottled in bond), rye, scotch and maybe an Irish whiskey. We learned what Bottled in Bond on the label means. In 1897 the government passed the Bottled in Bond Act. It was their way of ensuring whiskey was made properly. The Distillers must follow strict regulations. It must be distilled at one distillery, in one distilling season. Be aged at least 4 years in a federally bonded warehouse. Be bottled at exactly 100 proof and be produced under U.S. government supervision. So it means it's really, really good! Next time you have
