It's 11:45 at the Hilton, we were served Angus Cheeseburgers. **President Bill** rang the bell and we began the meeting.

**President Bill** had **Jim Dugoni** give the thought, lead the pledge and the 4-way test. His thought for the day reflected a sports theme, (honoring our Olympic success that just concluded), of this day in Sports History.

**August 20, 1920**, the first radio broadcast of a sports event in the United States took place. It was a boxing match between Johnny Ray and Johnny Dundee, held at the Motor Square Garden in Pittsburgh, PA.

Broadcast on KDKA in Pittsburgh as the station's announcer, Harold Arlin, provided a blow-by-blow account of the fight which lasted eight rounds and ended in a draw.

August 20, 1920, the precursor to the NFL, the American Professional Football Conference is founded at a Hupmobile auto dealership in Canton, Ohio. It consisted of only Ohio teams at first but in 1922 the name was changed to the NFL. Hupmobile was a line of automobiles built from 1909 through 1939 by the Hupp Motor Car Company of Detroit.

**August 20, 1945**, 11 days after the Atomic bombing of Nagasaki, Japan, Brooklyn Dodgers utility player Tommy Brown homers to drive in his teams only run in an 11-1 loss to the Pittsburgh Pirates. Brown was only 17 and still remains the youngest player to homer in a MLB game.

**August 20, 1961**, the Philadelphia Phillies beat the Milwaukee Braves 7-4 in the second game of a double header to snap a 23-game losing streak, a modern record that this years White Sox almost snapped losing 21 games in a row.

**August 20, 2000,** then 24-year old Tiger Woods won the PGA Championship in a playoff over Bob May. He became the first player since Ben Hogan in 1953 to win three majors in one year. And Tiger was the first player to repeat as PGA champion since Denny Shute in 1937.

Wow, nobody will forget August 20th ever again!
