MARCH 20 RECAP: Pasadena Playhouse, Alive and Well.

The director of the Pasadena Playhouse, Danny Feldman, shared with us some important history of this historic institution. Not only was the 1925 building considered state-of-the art, but it was built by a very enthusiastic local theater arts community that participated in creating plays, building sets, hosting premiers and training actors. The Playhouse had a significant role in training actors during the film industry's transition from silent movies to "talkies" and later trained news anchors when televisions replaced radios. Over the years, many talented actors were trained at the Playhouse, including Raymond Burr, Victor Mature, Ernest Borgnine, Eleanor Parker, Charles Bronson, Ray Vasquez, Gene Hackman, Dustin Hoffman, Sally Struthers, and others.

Danny Feldman has been with the Playhouse since 2016. Under his leadership, the Playhouse has undergone a remarkable transformation, earning the 2023 Regional Theatre Tony Award. Feldman has staged numerous memorable productions and is deeply committed to making theater accessible to all, expanding education programs like Summer Theater Camps, Musical Theater Boot Camps for students, and producing theater for young audiences.
