
Attribute 2: This governor likes to cook, listen to the Beetles, and has a history of rock climbing...who is he? **If you**

UN Youth Summit

The Youth UN Summit at the District Conference is designed for high school and college-level participants. Over two - two-hour sessions on Saturday, April 12, participants will engage with Matthias Sundholm, the Communications Advisor to the United Nations Security Council Counter-Terrorism Committee Executive Directorate (CTED).

The summit is designed to empower and strengthen the position of young people within and outside the United Nations System. Participants will explore challenges faced by young people across the globe and will have their collective voice shared with different UN entities, governments, academia and media stakeholders. *This is an opportunity of a lifetime*. Registration is only \$5 and helps offset the cost of pizza and



drinks for lunch. Clubs are asked to sponsor young people in their area. Seats are limited - only 60 seats are available.

Registration will open on February 20, 2025. A PMail will be sent out with notification of the registration opening and links to register the participant.
