If you've never shot clay targets with a sporting shotgun before, get ready for a fun and exciting experience! It's a little like golf, but with a machine launching your target up in the air for you!

We will have two groups, one for experienced shooters to go off and shoot together, and the other for those new to clay shooting.





Your \$50 includes the cost of paying our instructors, plus use of the equipment (if not bringing your own), plus one box of 25 shells (as well as 25 clays). That's probably enough for the beginners. The experienced shooters can purchase additional clays and shells.

Afterward, we'll regroup at a nearby restaurant for a festive aprèsshoot lunch!
