
New Clubs!!!





With the introduction of this platform, Rotary Showcase has been retired. All Rotary and Rotaract service projects have been transferred to the Service Project Center.



October 4-7, 2024

Approximately 60 children from infants to 18 years old will have surgeries (some several at the same time) to repair their birth defect of cleft palate or lip. Rotarians help keep the children entertained while they are waiting for surgery, get them to meals and even observe surgeries.
