

Individualized DACdb Training for Clubs

We hope you're enjoying DACdb! The DACdb Transition Team is still available to schedule individualized training for club boards and members!

To book a call with DACdb for a board overview, click <u>HERE</u>. To schedule actual training for your club, contact Elizabeth Kirby at DACdb at <u>elizabeth.kirby@memberminderpro.com</u> with a few dates and times.

Remember that the District has switched to DACdb completely, including our new website https://rotaryd5500.org, and the DACdb system is up, operating and available for ALL D5550 clubs and members to use NOW for free! You just need a login which your club officers or Leo Lawrenson can provide if you don't already have one.

All clubs have now authorized DACdb as at least a View-Only Membership Management vendor on MyRotary, so District will get any membership data changes your club makes on DACdb or ClubRunner and Synchronize or Compare with RI (ONE-way synchronization). If your club is ready to use DACdb as its primary membership manager (almost 20 D5500 clubs are!), please change from "View-Only" to "View and Edit" at RI and then also set the Rotary Interface option on the DACdb Club Information page to "RI Direct Connect†to allow TWO-way synchronization between DACdb and RI for your club.







