## How Rotary Supports Basic Education and Literacy



Worldwide, 67 million children have no access to education, and more than 775 million people over the age of 15 are illiterate. Rotarians support educational projects that provide technology, teacher training, vocational training teams, student meal programs, and low-cost textbooks to communities. Our goal is to strengthen the capacity of communities to support basic education and literacy, reduce gender disparity in education, and increase adult literacy.

He attended Camp RYLA as a high school junior and recognized that he had something inside him to help others in need. The following year, he returned as a counselor to give students the same experience he was fortunate enough to receive.

Albert joined the Rotary Club of Burbank Noon at the age of 19 where he remains active.

Albert is CEO of Home Again Los Angeles, a nonprofit homeless service agency committed to helping homeless families with children to move into shelters and work towards securing permanent housing.

The cutoff date for room reservations is September 19, but we may fill up before then. The King bedded rooms are sold out in both towers; rooms with two double beds are still available.


There is another large group in at the same time and the resort always sells out. Please make your reservations soon so you won't be disappointed.




