During our announcements, Rick Rowell reminded us of the upcoming Camp Enterprise event scheduled for February 21-23, 2025 and the need for volunteers. Gaines Bagby led the recognition of Tillery Castillo (PHF+2), Jim Gdula (PHF+2) and Jeanine Olsen (PHF).

The "Thank Goodness" basket was presented by Sargeant-at-Arms, Andy Barclay and President Darrick Eugene announced that he was thankful that his son Felix Eugene had recently been accepted to the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, explaining the **Army!** emblazoned football jersey President Eugene sported during the meeting.

Finally, in the last half hour, Dr. Abelson introduced our speaker for the day, Dr. Cecil Reynolds to discuss "Perspectives on Death as a Penalty: A view from the Trenches." Dr. Reynolds, brings a wealth of knowledge and experience related to the field of psychology and the death penalty. Although he is against the death penalty as applied, he is not an "abolitionist," believing there are certain instances where the death penalty is deserved. Dr. Reynolds, said that in his experience as an expert in over 150 death penalty cases, the vast majority of the defendants suffered from some form of mental incapacity. He firmly believes that the death penalty should not be applied in those instances and that it does not serve as an effective deterrent. Another thing Dr. Reynolds emphasized was the costs of a life sentence vs. the death penalty. Dr. Reynolds shared that every time the state seeks to execute someone, it costs roughly \$4 -\$5 million dollars given the trials, appeals, resource time and personnel hours compared to maintaining someone in prison for life which costs about \$400,000 total. In all, Dr. Reynolds delivered a sobering take on the death penalty based on his personal experience and perspective.
