The florist shop sustained too much damage and expense to be rebuilt. She decided on a career change in 2022 and became the assistant director of Southdown Museum and then, in 2023, the managing director of Southdown Museum until 2024. Currently, she is the managing director of Residence Plantation/Volumnia House, the oldest working farm in Terrebonne Parish. She serves on the board of Explore Houma and the vice president of the Houma Irish Italian Parading Club.

She wrote a Children's book "Adventure's of Gum Beau Welcome to Louisiana." It's about how Southdown Plantation got its name from a breed of Sheep – Southdown Sheep from England. She has a second book coming out in October 2024 that will have more history, Cajun tales and focuses on Wise Old Dog from the Residence Plantation.
