Important message from DG Mark regarding DACdb billing issues

I am writing to address questions about a billing from DACdb many of our District 6360 clubs have recently received. The charge reflected on this bill is in the amount of \$2.99 per club member for a new product called IGNITE Mobile which is an application members can install on their mobile device. Many club members do not use this product and we do not endorse this billing.

I want to clarify that there has been no change in policy about what DACdb services the District covers for the clubs. District 6360 directly pays DACdb for the subscription that includes the basic services provided by DACdb and will continue to do so. When a club pays their dues, the district covers the expense of DACdb.

Each club should make their own determination as to whether this is an additional value added service they want to pay for out of the dues they charge their members. The basic services of DACdb will continue to be paid for by the district. Personally, I do not use IGNITE Mobile or DACdb Mobile but have the full application loaded on my phone. It works just fine.

It has been years since the district increased member dues and as you know, there was no increase this year. Please let me, Ed Foster or Mark Rodge know if you have additional questions.
