GRANTS MANAGEMENT SEMINAR

To participate in global grants, Rotary International requires that clubs complete the content included in the Grant Management Seminar. While our district has held in-person and Zoom events to present and discuss this information, you can also qualify by completing the Grant Management Seminar learning plan on Rotary's Learning Center. The courses in this plan cover details about and requirements for global grant through The Rotary Foundation. Once completing this learning plan, clubs only need to complete the Grant Management Recertification course in subsequent years to maintain qualification. (New recertification courses are available after July 1 every year).
