The Super Bowl is Feb 9, 2025.


We are doing our last football pool for Polio Plus!

Service To Youth Award Recipient Honored

On Friday, January 31, 2024, the Westerville Sunrise Rotary Club honored **Shelly Corl**, Science Teacher at Westerville South High School, with a Service to Youth award for her outstanding dedication to our local students.

Ms. Corl's classroom is a place where students can literally see how science can be used in a variety of fields, and she prepares them for state testing in a way where they feel safe to ask questions and push themselves. The back of her classroom has a phrase on it: "We can do hard things". She embodies this, and she works each and every day to make her kids believe it and believe in themselves.

Serving as a mentor, Ms. Corl has helped former students to make college pro and con lists to narrow down their choices and helped students craft letters to teachers to ask for help or to apologize when they did something wrong and didn't handle a situation the best way possible.

Ms. Corl works well with the other teachers in the science department. She is constantly helping to solve problems and crises that impact kids – always asking "how will this impact the students?" She will walk other teachers through ideas and labs and scenarios long after the workday is done if it means that just one kid will understand something better.

The teacher who nominated Ms. Corl said, "One can always tell which students had Mrs. Corl as a teacher, as they come to other teachers' classes more than prepared, knowing how to read graphs, work in a lab setting and how to work with different groups of people. They know how to put differences aside and work toward the greater good."

Service to Youth award recipients receive an engraved plaque, as well as a gift card and box of cookies from Kroger. They are invited to join a Rotary Club breakfast in May and will be honored with a flag at The Field of Heroes event Memorial Day Weekend 2025.


