You don't want to miss our speaker on Tuesday, February 11 at noon at The Boat House - Kristin Watt!

Kristin Watt was recruited to join the women's basketball team at The Ohio State University in 1981. She played from 1981 to 1985, and continued to attend the games in 1986, sometimes harassing the referees from the front row of seats under the basket. In 1987, she became the color commentator on the radio broadcasts of OSU women's basketball.

She has done that ever since, has worked with five head coaches, many assistants and has known individually all the players. She travels with the team, eats with the team, and is a true expert. She has covered every Big 10 Women's Basketball Tournament. She led the effort to induct women athletes into the OSU Sports Hall of Fame and was the first President of the reconstituted Varsity O. She was the first female alumni representative on the OSU Athletic Council and in 1919 served as Chair of The Ohio State University Alumni Association Board.

Oh, and she also practices law. She is a long-time partner at the Vorys law firm and leads its environmental law practice, making frequent appearances on "Ohio Super Lawyer" lists.

She will share with us her direct observations 43 years of Ohio State Women's Basketball.
