Lunch Payment

There have been some questions from members about payment for lunches, so I wanted to take some time to review it here - I will also address this at a weekly meeting.

After a few membership surveys, the Board concluded that starting with my term, we should move back to The Boat House at lunchtime. The results of the surveys pointed toward this still being the solution most people wanted, even though it meant an increased cost.

At The Boat House, there is a fee to rent the room and A/V (we're required to rent their A/V), unlike Scioto Country Club. With this, we decided to **re-implement the meeting fee of \$10 for every person** who attends. That way we don't lose money on lunch. **This fee is NOT included in your dues, it must be paid at the door** unless you have pre-paid for lunches.

The meeting fee of \$10 is the base price of attending a meeting, and that includes coffee and dessert. Lunch is an *additional* \$25 - the meeting fee is still required even if you are eating lunch, *for a total of \$35*.

When putting together the budget for 2024-2025, we also knew we would have lowered administrative costs in the absence of a paid staff person. With that knowledge, **to offset the higher lunch expenses**, **we lowered dues for all members and offered an additional early bird discount.** You can also save money on lunch by pre-paying.
