You don't want to miss our speaker for November 19 lunch at The Boat House - former Ohio State football player Jeff Logan!



An All-Big Ten and Academic All-America selection, he led Ohio State to four conference titles and four New Year's Day bowl appearances. He was a teammate of NFF Board Member and College Football Hall of Famer Archie Griffin and 2016 Hall of Fame inductee Tom Cousineau during his career in Columbus."

Jeff later entered broadcasting and still serves as an analyst for high school games on the CW, makes Friday morning appearances on 99.7 The Blitz and joins 610 WTVN before and after Buckeyes games.

Nominations for the Rotary Club Board
