**Patty Whisman** introduced today's speakers: Sue Larson, Executive Director of the Newark-Granville Symphony Orchestra, and Kathy Lorenz, art teacher at Newark High School.

Sue introduced the members of her brass quintet and shared highlights of the upcoming season, Music & Art: Reimagined, which reimagines the marriage of the performing and fine arts.

She shared that the orchestra was started in 1939 by Dr. Fleek Miller and violinist Sam Gelfer.
