January 9th Meeting Recap



The Speech Contest is open to all high school students in the central and western half of Kentucky.

The Rotary Club of Louisville will host students from Jefferson County for its Club contest on Wednesday, March 5th at 4:15 pm at Gilda's Club. Other Jefferson County Rotary Clubs will sponsor club contests at different dates, times, and location. Details provided to registered participants.

Theme: The Magic of Rotary

Length: 5-8 minutes

Delivery: Notes may be used at the first level, but memorization is preferred, and no notes will be allowed at subsequent levels (use will result in significant deductions).

Prize Money: \$300, \$200, and \$100 will be awarded at the Club level for first, second, and third place winners. First place winners at each level will proceed to sectionals, regionals, and finally the district level. Prize money is increased at each level; a total of **\$2,200** is **possible** for the student who advances to and wins the Rotary District 6710 contest.

Deadline for submission form: March 1, 2025

To be included, students need only request a student entry form (karen@gck.org) and complete NO LATER THAN March 1.

Thanks to President-Elect **Ken Selvaggi** who served recently along with **Hulyn Farr**, **David Snyder** and **Craig Scherman!**




