

2024 Louisville Sustainability Summit Highlights

It was great to see Rotarians at the 11th Annual Louisville Sustainability Summit <u>Hungry for Change:</u> <u>Climate, Equity & the Future of Food</u> last Friday at Sullivan University.



The Summit featured a keynote by Maddie Chera, highlighting the urgent need to address food waste and its environmental impact. She shared her research in South India, emphasizing the connection between food sustainability and community resilience. Maddie discussed the Greater Cincinnati Regional Food Policy Council's initiatives, including reducing food waste and promoting local food systems. Mayor Greenberg underscored the importance of sustainability in city planning, noting that food waste is the number one landfill item in Louisville. Panelists discussed strategies to reduce food waste, such as education, gleaning programs, and collaboration with local businesses and community organizations.


