Long-time Rotarian and past president **J. Barry Barke**r passed away on December 2nd. He joined the club on January 1, 1996, and served as the 2018-2019 Club President. He was a Paul Harris Fellow +4 and a member of the Paul Harris Society. He received the 2019-2020 Lifetime Service Award.

Barry led the Transit Authority of River City (TARC) as Executive Director for more than 20 years and was a national leader and advocate for public transit, particularly in the areas of accessibility and affordability.


Rotaract Club News


