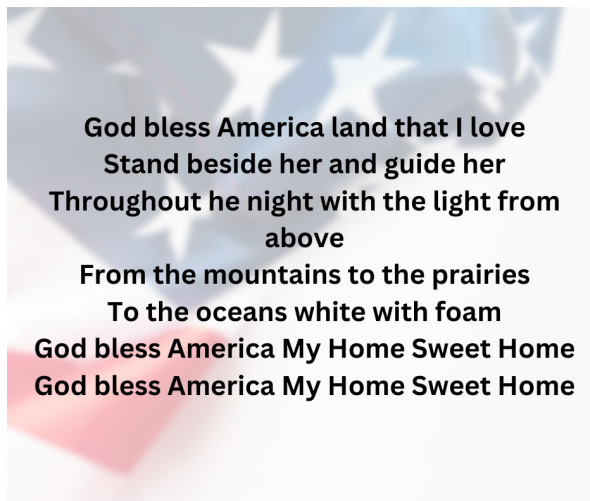

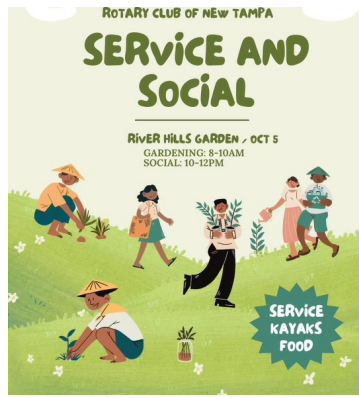

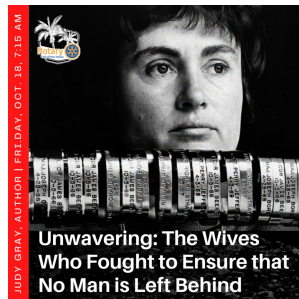


Helping After Hurricane Helene
