Guest Speaker/Program

President Surendra introduced our guest speaker, **Mr. Danny Broyles**, District Governor Nominee Designate. Danny is also an ambassador for the ShelterBox program.

Danny shared that ShelterBox was formed in 2000 in Cornwall, England. It is not a Rotary program; however, it was founded by Rotarians and is an endorsed effort to help around the world.

So far, ShelterBox has helped with 300 disasters, effecting 100 countries and over 2 million people. The kits are customized based on the needs of the area. Most include a tent for shelter, a water filtration system, clothes, and solar powered lighting.

Danny challenged the club members to help ShelterBox by doing the following things;

- Make a personal gift
- Become a HERO Club by donating at the following levels:
