Guest Speaker/Program

Kelly Knitter, Assistant District Governor and Augusta West Rotary member, introduced our guest speaker, **Ms. Beverly Trainer**. Beverly will be District Governor for the 2026-2027 Rotary year. She joined our club today to discuss a topic that is extremely important to her and our area; sex trafficking.

She shared that Rotary has formed the Rotary Action Group Against Slavery to help raise awareness for and fight against this terrible activity. Sex trafficking is a \$150 billion annual business and it is estimated 40.3 million people worldwide are enslaved. Trafficking includes labor, sex, organs trafficking, child soldiering, and child marriage.

Beverly shared many informative statistics about sex trafficking but perhaps the most disturbing was that Richmond County has the second highest number of cases in the state. This is not an Atlanta problem, but a statewide issue.

To help fight against this abuse, there will be two training classes offered March 28-29. One will be for law enforcement, educators, hospitals/first responders, and hospitality staff to teach them how to recognize victims of sex trafficking. The second will be for parents and children and will share information from industry experts and survivor testimonials. Watch for more details closer to the time of the event.

President Surendra led us in reciting the four-way test and then adjourned the meeting.
