Guest Speaker/Program

Lindsay Black introduced our guest speaker, Paul Aenchbacher, RN. Paul is a staff member in the Joseph M. Still Burn Center at Doctors Hospital in Augusta. He shared information with the club about the burn center and its services. The Still Burn Center is the largest in the United States and the world's third-largest. It has over 100 beds, 38 of which are in the Burn ICU. There are also dedicated operating rooms for the burn center at the hospital. The burn center specializes in pediatric burns and is the only hospital in the southeast certified by the American Burn Association. The burn center also has hyperbaric chambers that are often used after dive incidents and provide services for wounds and associated care. Patients are routinely referred to the center and arrive through air flight. The center sees patients from all around the southeastern United States and even has partnerships with countries in the Caribbean and South America.

President Surendra led us in reciting the four-way test and then adjourned the meeting.
