Guest Speaker/Program

Sue Parr introduced our guest speaker, **Retired Colonel Eric Toler**, Executive Director of the Georgia Cyber Center at Augusta University.

Colonel Toler shared his vision for the Cyber Center and put special emphasis on the need to go faster as the number and complexity of cyber threats continues to evolve. He showed a graphic illustrating there are over 550,000 unfilled cyber related jobs in the US.

He said the center's mission is to Educate, Innovate, Operate, and Cultivate. Within the Cyber Center, students are being educated, innovation is being fostered, interns are getting real world operational experience, and they are cultivating relationships with local, state, and federal agencies to combat cyber threats.

In closing, Colonel Toler warned that if we are to maintain our status as the Cyber Capital of the Southeast we must accelerate our research & development, leverage our collaborations with other schools and agencies, and prepare a workforce to fill the critical jobs that are currently available.

President Bill led us in reciting the four-way test and then adjourned the meeting.
