Meeting Minutes

President Scott opened the meeting at 12:15 PM. Brittany Burnett led the club in the pledge and invocation. Anna Reeves introduced guests and visiting Rotarians. President Scott reminded members to contribute to the "blue buckets" and reported that \$480,00 was raised last week (Inside Challenger Tripp Harrison; Outside Challenger Doctors Hospital), This week's Inside Challenger is Max Stachura and Outside Challenger is Integra Business Brokers.

Sunshine Report was given by Connie Melear who boldly predicted that "the Tigers" would win the National Championship of College Football in an evening game between Louisiana State and Clemson Universities. She also gave some examples of the outrageous cost of championship trophies (such as crystal footballs). Where are our priorities?

Signature Fundraiser Raffle Update: President Scott encouraged members to participate in the final push to achieve the Signature Fundraiser Raffle goal. As of meeting time, 210 tickets had been sold, representing 41% of our Club goal. We are behind where we were at this point last year. He asked the membership help reach the Club goal of 500 tickets, and in the process, have a chance to win a Mercedes-Benz A220 valued at \$37,000. If interested, call or text him at 706,799,1600. Tickets are \$100 and only 1500 will be sold. This annual fundraiser is hosted by the Rotary Club of Augusta, Fox 54, and Mercedes Benz of Augusta. - President Scott asked the membership to join him in recognizing and congratulating Tom Clark for being named one of the "100 Most Influential Georgians" by Georgia Trend Magazine for his work as Executive Director of the CSRA Alliance for Fort Gordon.
- He also reminded the Club that while there would be no meeting on Monday, January 20 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Day), this year's Georgia Economic Outlook Luncheon will be held on Thursday, January 23 at the Augusta Marriot. President Scott introduced the day's speaker, Club member Sue Parr, President of the Augusta Metro Chamber of Commerce since 2005, and celebrating her 30th year in the Chamber profession. She was accompanied by guest **Don Grantham** of the 12th District Georgia Board of Transportation. Their presentation reviewed the importance of renewing, at the March 24, 2020 voter referendum, the current penny sales tax that funds our regional transportation needs. They reviewed thee Transportation Investment Act of 2010 and the CSRA Region 7 TSPLOST, when we were one of three Georgia regions (Augusta-Richmond, Columbia, Glascock, Burke, Hancock, Jenkins, Jefferson, Lincoln, McDuffie, Taliaferro, Warren, Washington & Wilkes counties) to approve the penny tax in 2012. They pointed out that since 2013 "TSPLOST I" collected \$841M, and approved 84 projects (49 completed, 11 under construction, & 23 in design/engineering/pre-bid) worth \$631M as well as distributing \$210M Discretionary Funds to counties. They reviewed that it has delivered on the reasons it passed (Regional Commuting Patterns, Logistic Superiority, Airport Competitiveness, Business Attraction/Retention, Maximize Tourism, Leverage State Funding, & Essential Funding to counties for Discretionary Needs) – it is recognized nationally as a successful model of a local consumption tax funding local transportation needs. In addition to presenting visuals of completed projects, they reviewed some of the projects planned for "TSPLOST II – 2023-32" and encouraged the membership to help "spread the word" about the importance of passing the upcoming voter referendum.

President Scott reminded the members that the Speech Committee would meet today after the meeting, encouraged attendance at the Georgia Economic Outlook Luncheon on January 23, and asked the members to stand and join him in the 4-Way Test, after which he rang the bell at 1:15 PM to adjourn the meeting.
