Guest Speaker/Program

Dustin Young introduced our guest speaker **Shell Berry**, President/CEO of the Community Foundation of the CSRA.

Shell Berry discussed the role of the Community Foundation in connecting philanthropic community members with nonprofits and community initiatives within the CSRA. She discussed how the Foundation strives to cultivate generosity, strengthen non-profits, and engage the community. The Foundation has \$158 million total charitable assets. The Community Foundation joined with the MCG Foundation and the Boys and Girls Club of the CSRA to build the two buildings called the Hub West and Hub East located on Chafee Avenue near the corner of Fenwick Street. The buildings will provide a common housing for local based nonprofits, The Hub West will house Augusta Locally Grown, Augusta University Literacy Center, Harrisburg Family Health Care and Rise Augusta.
