Dirk Meyer is Music Director of Augusta Symphony and the Duluth Superior Symphony Orchestra in Minnesota. He has guest conducted many orchestras throughout the United States and abroad. Dirk talked about the upcoming 2020 schedule of concerts.

Katherine Garcia is Senior Event and Facility Services Manager with the Miller Theatre.

Katherine mentioned the Miller Theatre has hosted 150 events and 20 Symphony events in 20 months, 105,000 guest and 5.9 million in gross sales. The Miller Theatre has hosted local art shows and participated in the Arts in the Hearts festival. 21% of market is from out of town generating more than \$2,000,000 impact for downtown.

Katherine discussed becoming a member for \$99.00/year. Becoming a member means access to event notifications, exclusive ticket opportunities and other perks. You will receive a Fast Pass entry to all events, early access and best seats in the house.

They offer a volunteer program with 150 active volunteers saving the theatre \$75,000 per vear.

The Knox Music Institute is housed in two floors above the Miller Theatre Box office and serves as small performance and lecture hall for the Augusta symphony as well as a rentable venue and office space for the Miller Theatre. It will also be the home of the Symphony's Community Cord Music Therapy Program, which launched in the fall of 2019.

Following the program **President Scott Williams** led the club in the four-way test and adjourned the meeting.
