Guest: A tribute to his grandfather by a village in France.



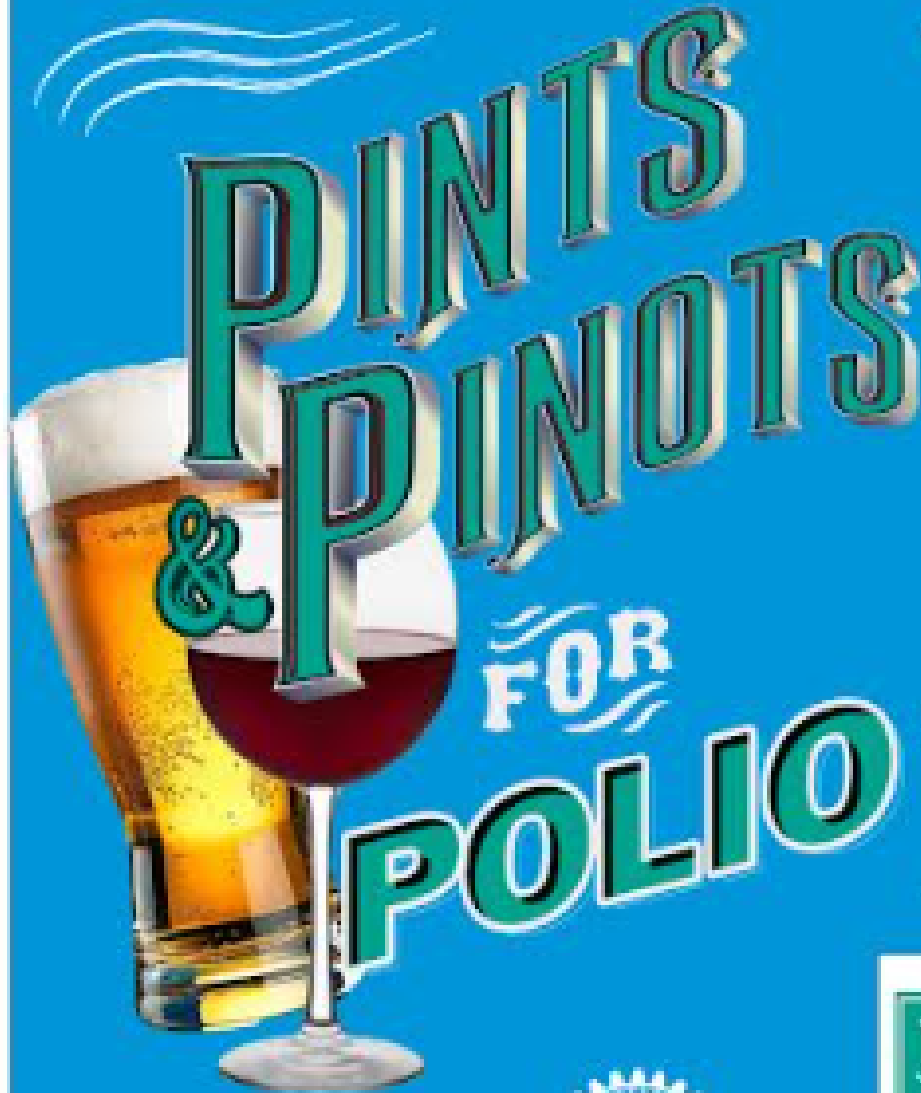
September 24th Meeting

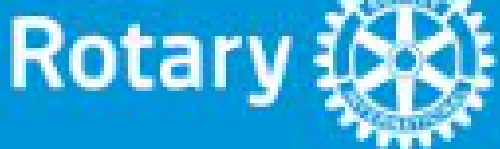

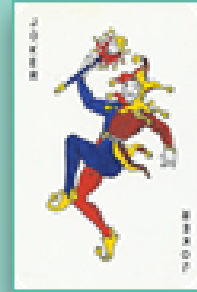
