Scott Ebner serves as Glynn County Chief of Police. He will be speaking with SSI rotary about the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office Citizens Academy. The academy's curriculum and training are not what you might expect. Typically, the students attracted to the academy are a culturally diverse group of people including bankers, businessmen and women, judges, housewives, schoolteachers, media representatives, retirees and citizens from all walks of life. Participants meet every Tuesday afternoon for eleven weeks at the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office training room in Bolivia from 1-4 pm. They learn about virtually every aspect of a deputy's job including administration, patrol operations, traffic enforcement and communications, criminal law, SWAT and hostage negotiations, crime scene investigations, corrections and many other areas.

Community involvement is the most powerful force any law enforcement agency has in the fight against crime. Through the Citizens Academy, citizens become more involved in making Brunswick County a better place to live. We at the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office believe this program leads to better understanding between citizens and law enforcement through education.

Chief Ebner has a master's degree from Seton Hall in Human Resources. His bachelor's degree is also from Seton Hall in Criminal Justice. Continued education is from the FBI National Academy and Naval Postgraduate School.


