In keeping with that long commitment to Service Above Self, the Membership Committee created a special dinner meeting to recognize members with 10+ years of service to the Club and, amazingly, that is half of our membership - one member is even celebrating 51 years of service - Don & Sally Glenn! However, when we add the tenures of all 101 members, Rotary Fort Lauderdale has given nearly 1,500 years of service to the Fort Lauderdale community!

Some of our memorable service for the betterment of our community has included: founding Junior Achievement of South Florida in 1959 (former JA president and CEO, Melissa Aiello, became our club's first female president in 2001-2002); Challenge Air helping differently abled children experience the confidence of flying; Turkeys Take Flight (our first global project feeding families at the holidays); AGAPE (feeding and supplying homeless persons); our annual Toy Drive (serving six charitable organizations serving impoverished children and their families); and \$3 million in scholarships given to local students seeking higher and technical educations.

The distinctive dinner was generously hosted by our corporate member, Broward Health.



Instructions for Member Directory

This directory is only available to members of the Rotary Club of Fort Lauderdale. The easiest way to access the member directory is to go to m.dacdb.com. This works on your desktop computer or on your smart phone.

You use the same login you use for the district site and our website. Once you have logged in, click on My Club and then Members and you will see a list of all our members, then click on the member you need contact information for and it will open up for you.

To add a shortcut to your smart phone

If you are on an android phone, you can click the three dots near the top right to see options and then click Add to Home screen and you will have a button that you can put where you want on your phone and have easy access to the directory.

If you are on an iPhone, make sure you use safari to go to m.dacdb.com and at the bottom of your screen you can click the icon that looks like a folder with an arrow, then click. Add to Home screen and you will have a button you put where you want and have easy access to the member directory.
