# Program - Veronica Guiterrez. Gwyneth's Gift Foundation

Gwyneth's Gift Foundation is dedicated to raising awareness of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the use of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs). Certified through Guidestar, the Rappahannock United Way Local Government Campaign (LGC), and Commonwealth of Virginia Campaign (CVC), they provide specific practices that build and reinforce life-saving skills by training community members in Hands-Only CPR and placing AEDs in businesses and public facilities.

They hope that through this work they can serve as a catalyst for increasing the survival rate of those suffering from an out-of-hospital cardiac arrest because they received immediate life-saving measures from a member within their community.

The mission of Gwyneth's Gift Foundation includes utilizing fundraising capabilities and partnerships to place AEDs in businesses and public facilities. Initially, the goal was to distribute at least one AED to a qualified recipient per quarter for a total of at least four per year. However, through community support and outreach, they have increased the number of devices deployed year-over-year.

In 2021, they placed 20 AEDs. They aim to expand this placement across our region and, over time, across the



#### Commonwealth.

Their goal is to achieve similar success in the Commonwealth as they engage citizens in the communities in which they live to provide Hands-Only CPR & AED Training. The GGF team and volunteers run all training events. Additionally, they have partnered with businesses, hospitals, first responders, schools, and civic organizations to host training events.

The Gwyneth's Gift Foundation Scholarship was formed in the loving memory and honor of Gwyneth Griffin. She is a testament to all of us on how to live freely with undeniable optimism and compassion toward others.

They accept applicants who meet the following criteria:

- Best exemplifies the virtues that most represent Gwyneth Griffin compassion, service, leadership, determination, and acceptance.
- ❖ Are a graduating senior at a Stafford County High School in the scholarship calendar.
- Will attend an institution of higher learning in the Fall following graduation.
- Demonstrate participation in community service activities and/or extracurricular activities.
- Are in good standing, a role model to others, and possess demonstrated leadership characteristics.
- ❖ Have not received disciplinary action in detention or above six months before the application deadline.
- \* The Scholarship application will OPEN November 2024.

# **Help Grow Public Awareness of CPR & AEDs**

- ❖ Become CPR trained or certified and then encourage five friends to get trained. Training can be obtained through local chapters of The American Red Cross, American Heart Association, and often through your local fire and EMS services.
- Plan a Hands-Only CPR & AED Training at your place of work or business. Look to see if an AED is available in your building.
- Find out if your local schools are in need of an AED then help them acquire funding. Money for the purchase of these devices may be obtained with the help of local businesses, grants from local hospitals, Gwyneth's Gift Foundation or raised via fundraisers and /or the school's PTA. The opportunities for acquiring a device or funding are numerous.
- ❖ Learn how your community can earn a HEARTSafe designation or support organizations like PulsePoint.




