3) OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT

To talk about this disorder is to face a series of ideas that, far from contributing to create awareness and inform, generate confusion. It is even possible that the diagnosis of a child with this condition may be delayed due to ignorance of the subject, which is why CRIT Sonora has as a project to open a clinic specialized in the care of children with autistic spectrum.



4) DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT, SHORT AND LONG TERM DEGLOZED

Find teaching material and software to be able to offer the services, since each child will receive 35 hours of therapeutic intervention monthly and is attended through a group, with the development of an individualized plan that allows them to develop secondary skills, such as self-regulation or socialization.

With a treatment based on the following characteristics:

- Structured environment.
- Positive behavioral support
- Work with the environment.
- Social participation exercises.
- Family participation.

5) EXPLANATION OF THE SUSTAINABILITY OF THE PROJECT IF YOU HAVE IT

People with autism have challenges and limitations in activities because of their condition, especially, face barriers in the environment that hinder or prevent their participation. That is why Autism Spectrum Disorders are considered a disability. It is important to know that the greater the environmental barriers, the greater the disability and the more accessibility and supports exist, the lower the disability.

In Sonora, there are few centers specialized in Autism, so that socioeconomic studies will be carried out on people who will enter the program looking for those who are in a high stratum to be able to grant or sponsor the family in a more vulnerable situation.

Due to the increased of autism, CRIT SONORA seeks to initiate a program of Autism Telethon diagnostic services, counseling, and referral.

This specialized clinic within CRIT SONORA will receive tailored intervention with professionals specialized in working with people with autism. Also, their families receive emotional support and training.

Knowing that the earlier the intervention is, the better the prognosis will be, the efforts at the Telethon Autism Center focus on the first 8 years of the child's life, where adequate care will have a greater impact.

Children will receive attention in the areas of communication, behavior, socialization, daily living skills, sensory integration, and academic skills, with the ultimate goal being that children develop basic skills that allow them to participate in their context.
