Objective: Empower the lives of young people in vulnerable areas and with high rates of violence, through workshops, conferences and activities that encourage them to improve their personal, family and academic environment.

2) Project description, breakdown short and long term:

The project consists of an annual event lasting six months, which includes various workshops taught twice a week by professionals in the field, where young people are provided with the following topics:

- Responsible sexuality
- Contraceptive methods and their consequences
- Abortion





- Drug addiction and its consequences
- Domestic violence and dating
- Prevention of sexual abuse and harassment
- Conflict resolution in a non-violent way
- Workshop forgiveness as a method of healing
- Emotional intelligence
- Self-esteem
- Ecology and environmental care
- Art activities.

The long-term objectives are to reduce the rates of violence, early pregnancy, school drop-out and drug addiction and gang prevention. Increase the level of education of the ANAPRA community.

3) EXPLANATION OF THE SUSTAINABILITY OF THE PROJECT IF AVAILABLE.

The project was started in 2010, by the Sembradores de Paz y Esperanza A.C. and to date there have been 8 events.

4) DIRECT AND INDIRECT BENEFICIARIES BREAKING DOWN BY SITUATION OF VULNERABILITY, ATTACHING IMAGES

The direct beneficiaries are 32 young people per annual event adding up to 256 young people and their respective families. The indirect beneficiaries are approximately 12,500 inhabitants of the ANAPRA area.
