- 3) OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT: The main objective of this project is to improve the conditions in the area where food is prepared.
- 4) DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT, SHORT AND LONG-TERM BREAK DOWN: Our community dinner/kitchen is a project which has been operating for 4 years. At the beginning of this project we started preparing and delivering 30 meals a day, today we are able to prepare and hand out around 500 meals a day, we also deliver 200 sandwiches at city hospital once a day.

On the short term we intend to increase our cooking capacity in order to double the amount of meals prepared to benefit more people in the community.

On the other hand, the long term goal of our project is to become a model that more people can adopt and replicate so we can help end the hunger problem in our country.

5) EXPLANATION OF THE PROJECT'S SUSTAINABILITY (AS APPLICABLE):



We hand out 500 meals a day. There is a minimum fee of \$10 pesos (50 cents of a dollar) per

family. This small fee helps us recover some of the expenses and thus continue to prepare food for the needy. We also have supporters who donate groceries and supplies as well as volunteers who help us to keep this project moving.
