3) OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

**The objective of the program is to offer integral medical attention to  
the children that are sheltered in our Institution.**

4) DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT, SHORT AND LONG-TERM BREAK DOWN

**This program seeks to equip strategic areas within the facilities of  
the Institution to to recover, maintain or control the good health of  
our beneficiaries.**

**We are looking to guarantee that the children have the best capacity to  
develop all of their potential in the future, so when they integrated  
to society in a functional family, they will have the possibility to  
become healthy individuals that will strength the social tissue.**



We currently serve 97% of babies under two years of age and 60% of children between 2 and 5 years adopted under the law of adoptions in the State of Querétaro.

The program contemplates three venues:

- Corrective Medicine. To attend health problems that the children already have for being victims of abandonment and mistreated. Includes permanent attention from our internal doctor, rehabilitation and physical stimulation, support in consulting with external specialists, studies, clinical analysis, medication, surgeries, and hospitalization.
- Immediate Medical Attention in case of emergencies.
- Preventive Medicine. Supervision, prevention and control of the health, which includes deworming and vaccines campaigns, vitamins, and the installations sanitary control.

#### Services

- Income Diagnosis.
- Permanent care of the internal doctor.
- Physical rehabilitation and early stimulation.
- Support for consultations with external medical specialists.
- Application of prophylactic measures (Vaccination, deworming and vitamins).
- Management and support in case of surgery, clinical analysis, medical studies, etc.
- Program of immediate attention in case of emergencies.
- Stimulation and physical rehabilitation.

The program is successful in the measure in which the children enter the institution, fulfill the profile designed for them in which the health area has a superbly important part, related in the following:

"A child who graduates from our home is a happy child who has regained his self-esteem and is capable of giving and receiving love, with the tools he needs to successfully integrate into a family and grow within it as a person capable of facing his problems autonomously and assertively."

- Good physical health



- Well established hygiene habits
- Healthy eating habits
- Adequate emotional abilities for its age (capable to face the different circumstances they will have to live with)
- Adequate Social skills for its age (kids are capable of healthy relationships)

#### 5) EXPLANATION OF THE PROJECT'S SUSTAINABILITY (AS APPLICABLE)

La Alegría de los Niños IAP is sustainable project thanks to the support of the private sector, which every year is increasing its percentage of participation, Mexican Organizations, International Organizations, the government of the state of Querétaro contributes only 1% of the annual budget and we also develop several events in order to raise funds.

The good results obtained every year, encourages us to increase the number of lives transformed and serve as a replicable social movement to continue the mission of the Institution. To achieve this, it is necessary to continue to have the support of social investors.

#### 6) DIRECT AND INDIRECT BENEFICIARIES BREAKING DOWN ITS VULNERABLE SITUATION, ATTACHING IMAGES.

According to the data of the National System for the Integral Development of the Family (DIF) in the State of Querétaro, as of March 2018, there were 370 children and teenagers located at the Social Assistance Centers (CAS) in the State of Querétaro. At the Institution we serve 128 of them. The children we receive are sent to us by the DIF of the State of Querétaro and they live at the Institution 24 hours a day 365 days a year.

Our beneficiaries are children under 6 years old and they come from dysfunctional households in poverty. They have been victims of mistreatment, abandonment or omission of care and therefore require a precautionary measure. A high percentage of them suffer some degree of malnutrition and most require immediate medical attention and physical and emotional rehabilitation.

Such a condition, if left unattended, can generate multiple physical and cognitive disadvantages, as well as increase their propensity for chronic diseases and disabilities. Given this problem, in La Alegría de los Niños we have set out to maintain a permanent Health Program, which ensures them to recover and maintain an optimal state of health.



In 2018, 128 children benefited from this program. It is estimated that in the year 2019, 133 will benefit.
