2) NOMBRE DEL PROYECTO

Comprehensive care for children from vulnerable families in San Miguel de Allende, Guanajuato./ Atención integral a niños y niñas de familias vulnerables de San Miguel de Allende, Guanajuato.

3) OBJETIVO DEL PROYECTO

Provide medical and economic support in therapies (physical rehabilitation, language, stimulation, learning, among others) to vulnerable families who attend Patronato Pro Niños de San Miguel de Allende, AC, whose children (boys and girls) have neurological conditions, having as a core the physical and mental health; the latter being the well-being that a person experiences as a result of their proper functioning in the cognitive, affective, medical and behavioral aspects; and it is the optimal display of their individual potential for coexistence.

4) DESCRIPCION DEL PROYECTO, CORTO Y LARGO PLAZO DESGLOSADO

In Mexico there are multiple deficiencies in the health sector that affect millions of Mexicans as they are unable to solve their health problems. They vary from problems generated by some type of disability, suffering or difficulties in acquiring expensive treatments. Many of these problems have been solved with the support that Patronato Pro Niños provides to the citizens of San Miguel de Allende.

When there are services that Seguro Popular does not cover, the Patronato Pro Niños provides the support for the patient to continue with the indicated treatment, be it transportation, medications, therapies or laboratory or cabinet studies, just to mention a few. After being evaluated by our doctors, our social worker helps families requesting the support of other social actors to cover some of these needs.

Patronato Pro Niños de San Miguel de Allende, A.C., acts as a facilitator in the quality of care, through agreements with therapy centers and therapists (physical rehabilitation, language, stimulation, learning, among others). These agreements make it possible for therapy costs to be reduced considerably. Patronato Pro Niños provides financial support to children from lowincome families, paying for therapy services they cannot afford.

Depending on the diagnosis and need of each child, they attend therapy 2 to 4 times a week, with a duration of 30 to 40 min per session.

The average **annual** cost per child is \$4,800.00 pesos.

The children to whom we provide support for therapy suffer from the following diagnoses:

Epilepsy, neurodegenerative and neurometabolic diseases, diseases of the peripheral nervous system of infectious or autoimmune origin, neuromuscular diseases, vascular diseases of the central nervous system and motor disorders. We also support children with developmental problems (i.e., early childhood brain damage, congenital metabolic diseases, cerebral palsy, spina bifida, hydrocephalus, mental disability, language developmental problems and autism; in addition to painful syndromes functional or psychosomatic diseases with neurological manifestation.

Short term:

1.- Provide financial support to the families that request it so that their children can obtain therapies (Physical rehabilitation, language, stimulation, learning, among others) according to the needs of each of the child.

Long term:

 Generate social impact on the population of low-income families we serve. This population is one in which some of the members present a limitation of some physical or mental faculty that precludes or hinders their normal development.
The recovery of children is slow, since most of the diagnoses they suffer from are neuromotor in nature, where physical, language and learning therapy must be given uninterrupted in order to observe their evolution, changes or advances.

Upon receiving these supports, families feel calmer and more confident that their children will receive adequate care, and they are also motivated to continue their treatments according to the indications of the attending physician.

Patronato Pro Niños understands the importance of providing a complete and comprehensive service to children and their families, a service that dignifies their lives. The services we provide or manage can not only drastically change their life, but can even save them.

5) EXPLICACION DE LA SUSTENTABILIDAD DEL PROYECTO EN CASO DE QUE LO TENGA

Without proper attention and treatment, the child not only suffers, but the family as a whole, Without treatment, parents, brothers and sisters do not believe there are achieving the best possible with the child/sibling. When the child receives treatment and is under the direction of qualified medical therapies being managed by Patronato Pro Ninos, this changes the family dynamic in both the short and long term. Treatments whether they accomplish dramatic improvement or partial improvement are themselves sustaining in that the child's life is improved for the rest of their lives. Families are also receiving a sustaining sense of acceptance in that they have done the "best" that they can.
